Note from Jerry Haasdyk

I am so grateful to the Lord for the opportunity of spending half my life supporting the exciting work of translating the Bible for minority languages. I am also deeply grateful to my church family here, such generous folks who have shared both financially and in prayer over the past 35 years!

I have never translated one Bible verse, but when people hear that I work with a Bible translation organization, they often ask, "So, how many languages do you speak?" I reply, "Only one language, a little bit." My roles have been in logistical support for the Bible translators, and also in raising funds to support national Bible translators in Africa and Asia. Most of the past 35 years have been spent serving here in Canada, with 13 years in the middle working in South Africa. There we supported 9 Bible translation projects in Mozambique and Botswana in any practical way needed. It was an exciting time for our young family, and the context for our three youngest children during most of their schooling. We are grateful for the lessons learned and the values passed on to our kids during that busy and rewarding time.

The last 11 years I have been serving with OneBook as a fundraiser, and also a liaison for several national Bible translation projects in Sudan and Uganda. Now that I'm retired from Wycliffe I am enjoying volunteering with OneBook a couple of days a week, still in the fund-raising side of things. Thanks to all of you at RPC for walking along with us so faithfully on this rewarding journey!


